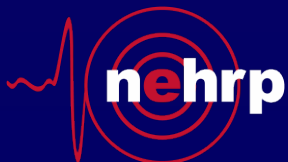

4. NSF budgets supported all NEHRP-related activities, excluding Agency Operations and Award Management (AOAM). They also included support for the George E. Brown, Jr. Network for Earthquake Engineering Simulation (NEES) and the NSF portion of the Global Seismographic Network (GSN), but excluded EarthScope funding.
5. USGS budgets supported all NEHRP-related activities, including the Advanced National Seismic System (ANSS), USGS Earthquake Hazards Program (EHP), and the USGS portion of GSN.

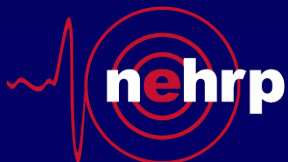

Brown, Jr. Network for Earthquake Engineering Simulation (NEES) and the NSF portion of the Global Seismographic Network (GSN), but excluded EarthScope funding. FY 2015-FY 2016 budgets included support for the NSF portion of the GSN and the earthquake engineering portion of the Natural Hazards Engineering Research Infrastructure (NHERI), but excluded Earthscope funding.
5. USGS budgets supported all NEHRP-related activities, including the USGS Earthquake Hazards Program (EHP) and the USGS portion of the GSN.

FY 2018-FY 2019 budgets included \$16.4M in "one-time" funding and did not include \$8.0M supplemental funding for seismic network restoration following hurricane Maria.
